Mandarin is a valuable contemporary foreign language that helps students develop their language skills. It can be challenging for British students as it doesn't use an alphabet, but learning Mandarin can enable them to communicate with millions of people worldwide. Mastering the language can also open up opportunities for travel and business, especially given China's position as the world's second-largest economy. In Chinese classes, students will have the opportunity to travel to China, experience the language and culture firsthand, and make new friends. Young British students who speak Mandarin have a significant advantage in tapping into the Chinese business market, which is increasingly important in today's global economy. With thousands of years of history, Chinese culture is endlessly fascinating, and a knowledge of Mandarin will enrich students' understanding of it and better equip them to navigate the global world.

The school conducts regular formative assessments during KS3 to ensure that all students master specific knowledge. Teaching is adjusted based on the assessment data to evaluate the success of the curriculum and the progress towards mastery. If needed, specific knowledge is retaught to the students within the allocated teaching time. Vocabulary knowledge is assessed through in-class tests at KS3. The curriculum aims to develop students into independent language learners who can speak and write in Chinese characters about various aspects of their lives. The MEP hurdle cross four skills will be taken by Y7 and Y8 in May every year to measure the impact of the curriculum on their learning.
