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Year 11 and 13 Mock Exams - Different strategies to support exam revision

As students in Year 11 and 13 prepare for their mock exams next week, here is a reminder of different strategies to support revision.

1. Establish a consistent Study routine:

- Encourage your child to use their revision timetable.
- Help them create a consistent and organised study routine.

2. Distraction free Study environments:

• A quiet and distraction free environment contributes to effective learning. For example: A dedicated space for studying, free from electronic distractions.

3. Active Retrieval Practice:

- Engage your child with active recall exercises such as flashcards or quizzing.
- Studies have shown that active recalling information from memory enhances long term retention and understanding.

4. Healthy lifestyle habits:

• Adequate sleep, regular exercise and balanced diet are essential for cognitive function.

5. Emotional support:

- Be supportive, offer encouragement, and help your child manage stress.
- Open communication about concerns and feelings can contribute to a positive mindset and increase confidence.




